COURSE DELIVERY

Courses are offered at the campus (on ground) and through distance learning (remote and online).

COURSE DATES

Trocaire offers courses in a variety of course lengths to provide flexibility and meet the many demands of our students. Courses are offered over the following timetables.

- Modules (5-weeks)
- 7-Week Classes
- Sessions (10-weeks)
- Semester (15-weeks) - most courses are offered in the traditional 15-weeks.

COURSE LOCATION

The course location is located in the **Room-#** on the course schedule.

- On ground (no designation) – offered 100% at the designated location. Main (Choate), Seneca, or Transit.
- Online (OL) – must be done on a weekly cycle, students who do not participate for a full calendar week will be marked absent and may not be allowed to make up work. These courses were always intended to be offered online.
- *Remote **Synchronous** (R) - must be done on a weekly cycle, at a specified time. This time will be defined on their schedule and the course syllabus. Students who do not participate at the defined time will be marked absent and may not be allowed to make up work.
- *Remote **Asynchronous** (R) - must be done on a weekly cycle, students who do not participate for a full calendar week will be marked absent and may not be allowed to make up work.

*Remote classes were intended to be offered on ground.
