## **General BSN Advising Information**

- This is a fully online program. Student advisement is typically done via email or phone.
- **The RN License is required in order to take NU courses past the first semester in the program.**
- Students may progress through the program at their own pace. There is no minimum credit requirement per semester.
- Students may complete the required liberal arts courses in any order except for MA200.
- **MA200 is a prerequisite for NU308.**
- Students may register for the Mercy Action Project (MAP 100) in any semester as long as the requirement is completed prior to graduation. If students completed MAP 100 previously at Trocaire, they are all set.
- NU 486 requires 135 hours of practicum experience in the final semester. Students should begin thinking about possible practicum sites and preceptors in advance and work with the Nursing Department for approvals. Although the student holds and owns primary responsibility for locating suitable preceptors to complete their hours, course faculty will assist through the process.
