1st Semester LPN Advisement

- PN 104 Fundamentals of Practical Nursing (7 cr.) – Lecture, Lab & Clinical
- PN 105 Practical Nursing II (7 cr.) - Lecture, Lab & Clinical
- NU 114 Medication Essentials I (1 cr.) Lecture Only
- **Students must register for a total of 7 PN/NU courses** (includes all required lectures, labs, and clinicals).
- BIO 131 & Lab Anatomy & Physiology II if not completed

2nd Semester LPN advisement

- PN 106 Practical Nursing III (7 cr.) – Lecture, Lab & Clinical
- PN 107 Practical Nursing IV (7 cr.) - Lecture, Lab & Clinical
- NU 115 Medication Essentials II (1 cr.) Lecture Only
- **Students must register for a total of 7 PN/NU courses** (includes all required lectures, labs, and clinicals).
- Any additional required general education core courses not completed.

The Mercy Action Project MAP 100 (0 cr.) must be completed prior to graduation. Students can register for MAP 100 in any semester, including summer session.

RN to LPN Program Transfer

- If a student is unsuccessful and dismissed from the second semester of RN but still retains a GPA of 2.5 and meets all admission requirements, the student may request to transfer into the Practical Nursing program. Having successfully completed the first semester of the Nursing program, the student would begin Practical Nursing with PN 105.
- If a student is unsuccessful and dismissed from the third semester of RN but still retains a GPA of 2.5 and meets all admission requirements, the student would begin Practical Nursing with PN 106 and PN 107 and could complete the program in one semester.
- If a student is unsuccessful and dismissed from the fourth semester of RN but still retains a GPA of 2.5 and meets all admission requirements, the student would begin Practical Nursing with PN 107 and could complete the program in one semester.
